We are delighted to announce that the “Forum-Mountmellick” has been approved for support fundings under the EU Just Transition Fund Regenerative Tourism and Placemaking Scheme for Ireland’s Midlands 2023-2026.

The support funding is earmarked for our new Tourist Accommodation premises in Marker Street, The Square, Mountmellick. County Laois.

This support will enable us to redevelop the historic Mews House at the rear of this historic building and provide self-contained accommodation to complement our existing tourist facility in the main Forum-Mountmellick Church-Manse and Coach House buildings in Patrick Street.

We look forward to opening-up this long-forgotten part of Mountmellick’s town square which is renowned for its Georgian buildings.

This Stage-1 development is just the beginning of our long-term vision, which includes a much-anticipated restaurant-tea rooms with improved access to the historic and one of the oldest Quaker Meeting Houses in Ireland.

Once completed, this project will enhance the town and help establish Mountmellick as a must-visit destination in Irelands Ancient East and a gateway to its hidden heartlands.


Planning Permission has been granted and the commencement notices successfully lodged to enable the long-awaited work to commence.




The Forum Mountmellick (The Square)


